Brighter Future Fund's Farmer & Rancher Emergency Resilience Grants

ELIGIBILITY QUESTIONNAIRE

Applicants must:

- Be an active farmer or rancher in the United States, directly impacted by recent disruptive events including but not limited to: government funding delays or termination, loss of markets, natural disasters, avian flu, and more. AFT will prioritize funding to small and mid-sized farms (as defined by the <u>USDA classification</u> based on annual gross cash farm income) who have previously faced challenges accessing traditional funding opportunities.
- Demonstrate financial need due to hardships caused by disruptive events in recent months and explain how grant support will enhance business resilience.
- Be committed to implementing soil health practices and environmentally beneficial agricultural techniques.
- 1. Program eligibility is determined on applicants meeting all of the following:
 - Be a "farmer" or "rancher" defined as an individual, group, or organization intentionally and actively cultivating annual or perennial crops or animals for harvest in one of the 50 US states or 5 US territories (American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, US Virgin Islands).
 - Provide proof of income at a value greater than \$1,000 in 2024 (or similar if the farm engages in barter, exchange, or community supply). This program does not intend to fund applicants who grow or raise products primarily for home, personal, or family use.
 - Terrestrial, soils-based agricultural production including agroforestry and silvopasture. Aquaculture, equine and forestry operations are ineligible.
 - Eligible farms or ranches must be for-profit operations. Nonprofits are encouraged to take advantage of alternate resources designed specifically for nonprofits.
